Isaiah 30:15

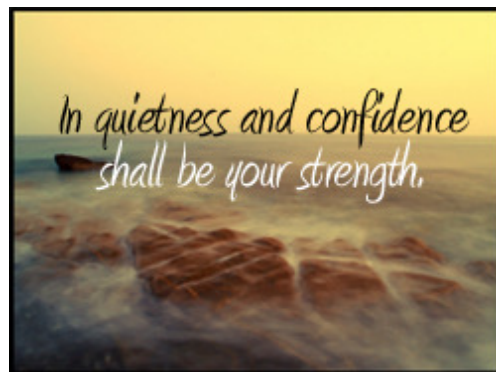
For thus says the Lord God, the Holy One of Israel; "In returning and rest you shall be saved; In quietness and confidence shall be your strength."

The Lord God has made a way. I would get my chores done as quickly as possible and steal away into the woods to be alone... I was searching for quiet, a place to think and meditate and just 'be.' I have looked for fifty years and I still search for those same quiet places. I know how desperately I need a place to think, to not have to be 'on' for anyone. I am finally finding my 'be still' place at the feet of the One who loves me more than anything and anybody else, my Savior, Jesus Christ, who does not need me to perform or be 'on' for Him. With the One who is the lover of my soul, I can be still and not have to 'do' anything. In Him, I have found a quietness and confidence that gives me the strength to finish this life's course.

Life can be a wilderness of underbrush, thickets, thorns, and briars. If we are not careful we can get all caught up fighting our way through the self-made and self-imposed 'stuff' that clouds our view, and catches our feet on the way to the path of rest. The Lord has promised us a place in Him, a rest, quietness and confidence where our strength can be renewed and refreshed, where we can be restored simply by our stillness and acceptance of who He is, not in what we are capable of doing. He is calling us to come to Him, return to Him, rest in Him.

As a little girl, I had to push through the thickets, thorns and underbrush to find my way to a quiet spot. Now there is no need to go straight into the woods through the thickets, briars, thorns, and underbrush of this present life. If we will only take a moment and 'be still' He will show us the way to His quiet spot, and we can find the path that our heavenly daddy, Abba Father, has made for us. Won't you return with me to His presence of rest, quietness, and confidence, and together we can find our strength in Him?
