Worship

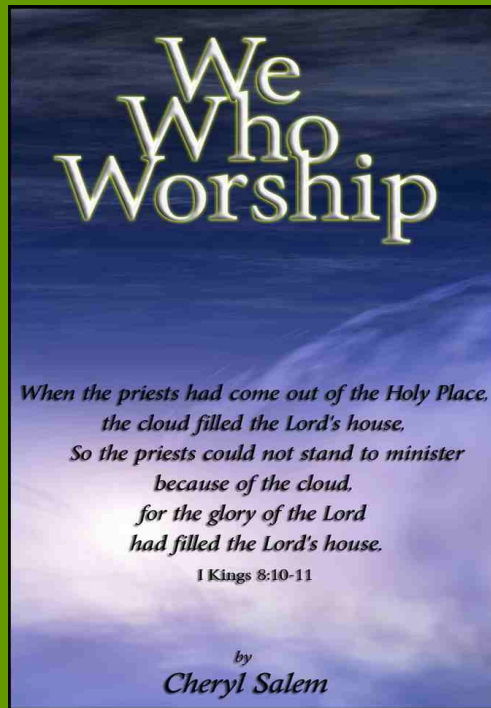
