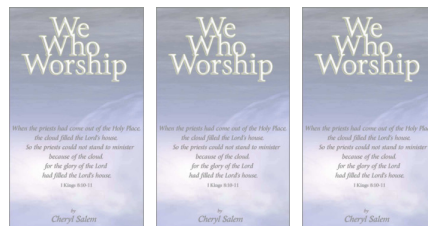

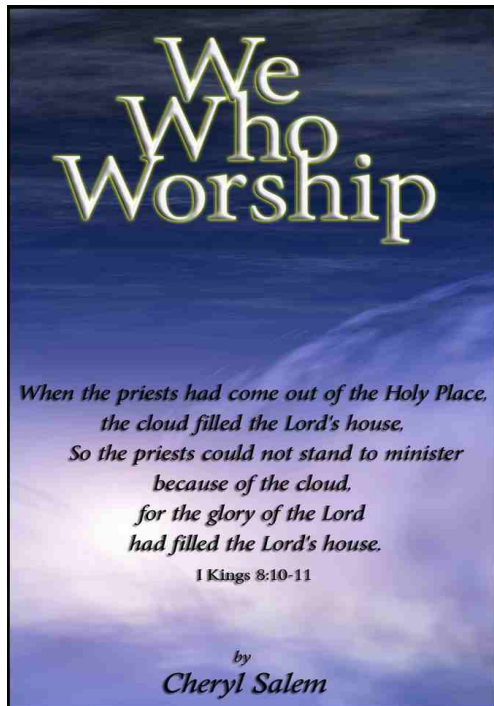

Chapter Four

Guard the Heart of Worship

Worshippers can be driven by their emotions. We must guard against this. In the Bible, many of the characters were worshipers. David wrote most of the Psalms in songs, poems, and spiritual songs. He was obviously very emotional. He had tremendous highs and his lows were to the depths of despair. As worshipers, we must guard our hearts and not be led by highs and lows of emotions.
