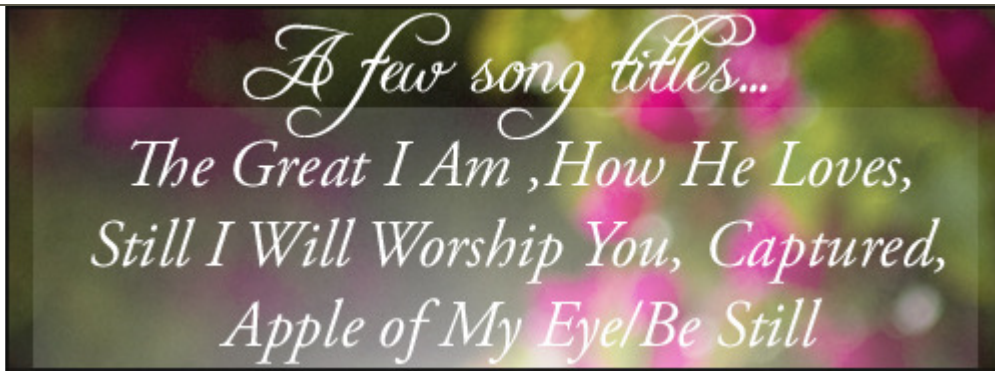
I remembered the Bible story of King Saul and how he was given such
